Once again we are opening the grounds and historic buildings to outside crafters. We welcome your application to sell your quality crafts. This juried craft fair is only open to crafters selling their own handmade products. Resellers are not admitted. Those crafters who offer a mix of items are welcome, but only their own crafts may be displayed and sold at the fair. Crafters may not share inside spaces.

The Harvest Craft Fair draws attendees due to its location and the fine food offered. Abundant nearby free parking allows convenient access. We proudly offer jams, jellies and baked goods from the kitchens of our parishioners. Additionally, a hearty lunch of homemade soups and breads is sold at reasonable prices. We offer extensive advertising in local and regional newspapers, internet sites, and signs are prominently displayed throughout Sudbury and neighboring communities. We are continuing our hourly raffle this year, for which patrons must be present to win. Your donations of an item of at least \$15 value provide the raffle prizes.

Become part of our New England tradition and make it a profitable event for all.

HARVEST CRAFT FAIR OPERATING RULES AND EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES

Crafts: All crafts must be hand created by the crafters. No reselling is allowed. The sale of

jewelry must be approved in advance based on your application.

Unloading: Materials may be unloaded in the Church parking lot. Crafters will be directed to parking

locations and to remove their vehicles as soon as materials are unloaded.

Parking: Free parking in nearby lots.

Set-up: Friday, Oct. 13th from 6:30 PM- 8:00 PM; Saturday, Oct. 14th from 7:30 AM- 9:30 AM

All setups must fit within the space allocated. All set-ups must be completed by 9:30 AM of October 14th. The Harvest Craft Fair opens promptly at 10am. Booths must remain

set-up until the 4pm closing.

Aisles: Must be kept clean, navigable and safe.

Exhibitor Areas: Must be returned to their original condition after the Fair is over.

Liability: First Parish of Sudbury assumes no liability for any property or goods of exhibitors.

Exhibitors will hold harmless First Parish of Sudbury for any personal liability due to

exhibitor's acts or omissions.

First Parish of Sudbury reserves the right to make and enforce all operating rules, and, in its sole discretion, to require the removal from sale of any items deemed inappropriate for sale at the Harvest Craft Fair. Exhibitors must comply with all laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the Town of Sudbury, including all laws and regulations dealing with licensing and sales taxes.

Food: Coffee will be provided at no charge during the day. Our famous homemade bread & soup

lunch will be available for your purchase and delivery to your booth.

Deadlines: Applications must be postmarked by May 1, 2017, and confirmations will be mailed early June. **Refunds:** No refunds will be made once an exhibitor has been accepted, unless the space can be filled by

September 1, 2017, after which date no refunds will be made to any admitted crafter for any

reason.

NO SMOKING is permitted in the First Parish buildings.

Application Agreement

HARVEST CRAFT FAIR OPERATING RULES AND EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES

Application: Your check must be for the total due on your 1st choice location, including the fee for

table/chairs/electricity, if you wish us to provide these. Refunds for those accepted for their 2nd or 3rd choice location will be made AT THE FAIR. Rejections will have their Booth check returned to them. A waitlist is maintained and those checks are held pending final decision. All crafts must be hand created by the crafters. No reselling is allowed. No Sharing of Craft

Crafts: All crafts must be hand created by the crafters. No re space by 2 or more crafters is allowed for inside spaces.

Raffle: Every Crafter must donate a craft with a value of at least \$15. This item must be presented

upon check-in.

Unloading: Materials may be unloaded in the Church parking lot. Crafters will be directed to parking

locations and to remove their vehicles as soon as materials are removed.

Parking: Free parking in nearby lots.

Set-up: All setups must fit within the space allocated. Most inside spaces are 8'x6', with a few 10'x6'

spaces. Stall spaces are only 9' wide, so 10x10 tents/display do not fit inside without

modifications. This year we offer two outdoor spaces 10'x12'.

Friday, Oct. 13th from 6:30 PM- 8:00 PM; Saturday, Oct. 14th from 7:30 AM- 9:30 AM. All set-ups must be completed by 9:30 AM of October 14th. **The Harvest Craft Fair opens**

promptly at 10am. Booths must remain set-up until the 4pm closing.

Aisles: Must be kept clean, navigable and safe.

Exhibitor Areas: Must be returned to their original condition after the Fair is over.

Liability: First Parish of Sudbury assumes no liability for any property or goods of exhibitors. Exhibitors

will hold harmless First Parish of Sudbury for any personal liability due to exhibitor's acts or

omissions.

First Parish of Sudbury reserves the right to make and enforce all operating rules, and, in its sole discretion, to require the removal from sale of any items deemed inappropriate for sale at the Harvest Craft Fair. where lunch and snacks may be purchased.

Deadlines: Applications must be postmarked by May 1, 2017 or a \$10 late fee will be added to those

postmarked from May 2 on. Confirmations will be mailed in early June.

Refunds: No refunds will be made once an exhibitor has been accepted, unless the space can be filled by

September 1, 2017. No refunds will be made after September 1, 2017 for any reason.

NO SMOKING is permitted in the First Parish buildings.
